#3 – Positive COVID-19 PCR Test_with Symptoms	Yes	 ✓ 3 days with no fever and ✓ Improvement in symptoms and ✓ 10 days since symptoms first appeared
#4 – Positive COVID-19 PCR Test_without Symptoms	Yes	 10 days after the PCR test was collected ➤ If symptoms develop during 10 days, follow return to school guidance for scenario #3.
#5 – Close Contact	Yes	 ➢ If the close contact is with a household member: If the positive individual can maintain isolation*, close contacts should quarantine for 14 days after the positive individual entered isolation If isolation cannot be maintained, household contacts should quarantine for the 10 days the positive individual is considered contagious plus an additional 10 days+ ✓ If the close contact is with a non-household member, return to school 10 days++ after the last exposure to the person with COVID-19 as long as you remain asymptomatic+++ ➢ If symptoms develop, follow return to school guidance for scenario #2.

^{*}Isolation is defined as the positive individual being in a room with a private bathroom and not coming out of that room for meals, socializing, etc. during their 10 day isolation period

- +There is an opportunity to test out of a portion of the last 10 days of quarantine. If the person identified as a close contact remains asymptomatic, they can be tested on or after day 15 of the 20 day quarantine period and with proof of a negative result, return to school on day 18.
- ++14 day quarantine if close contact is from the bus.
- +++There is an opportunity to test out of the last few days of the quarantine period. If the person identified as a close contact remains asymptomatic, they can be tested on or after day 5 of the quarantine period and with proof of a negative result, return to school on day 8.

Notifications:

- Staff and students should notify the school if an absence is due to COVID-19.
- Schools should notify the Bucks County Health Department by calling 215-529-7000 of any confirmed case of COVID-19 while maintaining confidentiality. The Bucks County Health Department will conduct an investigation and contact tracing, and provide appropriate guidance.
- These requirements may be adjusted in individual circumstances based on advice from Dr. Damsker.
