


### WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR TESTING?

- Bucks County School Employees and Contractor
- NEW Bucks County Children Who Have Exhibited Symptoms of COVID-19 for at Least 24 Hours

Bucks County is providing FREE COVID-19 testing to those noted above as being eligible and specifically at the sites listed below. Specially trained staff will be administering Rapid Tests to adults and will direct parents/legal guardians in administering the Rapid Test to their child. You need not disclose any reason for wanting a test and you will be provided with the results while on-site.

APPOINTMENTS ARE REQUIRED FOR TESTING AT ALL SITES!

#### **Children:**

Every child must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian who will be responsible for administering the nasal swab to the child.

#### Your test results are confidential and will not be shared.

Individuals can use the dated <u>negative test result</u> they receive on-site, in conjunction with the date they returned from travel or their last date of exposure, to be released from quarantine. <u>If an individual tests positive</u>, staff will do/direct a secondary (non-Rapid Test) to confirm the results (this will take another 20-30 minutes). <u>If the second test is also positive</u>, the <u>staff/contractor</u> will need to immediately call their school employer as per their employer's protocols and follow the process outlined by their school's Health and Safety Plan. <u>If the second test is also positive for a child, the parent/legal guardian</u> should inform the child's school/care facility of the results as per that organization's policy, if applicable.
